

Hemoccult SENSA Collection Guide

CLEARLY LABEL SPECIMEN WITH PATIENT'S FULL NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, DATE AND TIME OF COLLECTION. *Specimen may be rejected if this crucial step is omitted!*

1. Please obtain unopened Hemoccult SENSA card(s), applicator stick(s) and specimen bag from healthcare provider.



2. 7 days ...prior to... and during testing:

- No more than one adult aspirin (325 mg) a day
- No other non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs such as ibuprofen

NOTE: Please talk to your physician or pharmacist if you have any questions about medications you take regularly.

3. 3 days ...prior to... and during testing:

- No red meat (beef, lamb, or liver).
- No more than 250 mg vitamin C a day from supplements, and citrus fruits and juices. An average orange contains approximately 70-75 mg vitamin C. 100% of the recommended daily allowance of vitamin C is 60 mg. (Some iron supplements contain vitamin C in excess of 250 mg.)
- 4. Do not collect sample if visible blood is in your stool or urine (menstruation, active hemorrhoids, urinary tract infection).
- 5. Use any clean dry container or plastic wrap to collect stool sample.
- 6. Open the Hemoccult SENSA card by lifting the green tab underneath the name/address information. Use applicator stick to apply a THIN smear of stool to Box A.
- 7. Reuse applicator stick to obtain a second sample from a different part of the stool. Apply a THIN smear of stool to Box B.
- 8. Close cover and place specimen in specimen bag for transport.
- 9. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.
- 10. Deliver Hemoccult SENSA card(s) to healthcare professional. Cards containing samples may be stored at room temperature for up to14 days before testing.
