Title: Covid IgG Antibody (SARS-CoV-2) Test now performed at Cayuga Medical Center Laboratory

Test: Covid IgG Antibody

Explanation of change: Covid IgG Antibody testing is now performed at CMC Lab. This test targets the receptor binding domain (RBD) of the S1 spike protein. RBD represents the portion of the S1 protein that binds angiotensin-converting enzyme 2 (ACE2), the human receptor for SARS-

CoV-2.
