Title: Occult Blood Methodology Change

Test: Hemosure iFOB

## Explanation of change:

The methodology for stool occult blood testing has changed from Hemoccult SENSA to Hemosure. Hemosure has increased sensitivity, less interfering substances and is easier to interpret. Hemoccult SENSA cards will still be accepted during the transition from one method to the other.

	STBLOS Stool Occult Blood, Screen 3 CONSECUTIVELY collected specimens/stool cards (usually 3 different days)	Fobs Fecal Occult Blood iFOB, Screen 1 sample required
Stability	14 days	6 days room temperature 30 days refrigerated
