

Hemosure Collection Guide

CLEARLY LABEL SPECIMEN WITH PATIENT'S FULL NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, DATE AND TIME OF COLLECTION. *Specimen may be rejected if this crucial step is omitted!*

- 1. Obtain unopened Hemosure collection tube, specimen bag and stool collection container (if available) from healthcare provider.
- 2. Use any clean dry container or plastic wrap to collect stool sample.
- 3. Unscrew the purple cap from the sample collection tube. DO NOT POUR OUT THE LIQUID.
- 4. Poke spiral applicator into stool at 6 different sites. Use only enough fecal material to cover the tip of the applicator. DO NOT CLUMP, SCOOP, OR FILL THE TUBE.
- 5. Screw the applicator back into the tube and secure tightly.
- 6. Fill out personal information on attached label on tubes.
- 7. Place specimen in specimen bag for transport.
- 8. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.
- 9. Deliver hemosure collection tube to healthcare professional.
- Hemosure tubes containing fecal material may be stored 6 days room temperature or 30 days refrigerated.
