Title: Tube Type Changes for C2729 and LDHISO

Test: Breast Carcinoma-Associated Antigen and Lactate Dehydrogenase Isoenzymes

Explanation: Due to a change in specimen stability requirements from Mayo Clinic Laboratories, effective immediately, specimens for Breast Carcinoma-Associated Antigen (C2729) and Lactate Dehydrogenase Isoenzymes (LDHISO) must be drawn in red top tubes, centrifuged, and aliquoted into plastic vials within 2 hours of collection. These tests should only be collected at a laboratory Patient Service Center.
