Title: Gram Stain for Bacterial Vaginosis Sent to Referral Lab

Test: Gram Stain for Bacterial Vaginosis (BV)

Explanation of change:

Gram stains are rarely used for detection of bacterial vaginosis. Molecular testing is the preferred test methodology.

If gram stain for bacterial vaginosis is requested, the sample will be sent to Mayo Medical Laboratories instead of performed in-house.
