Title: Update in requirements for Therapeutic Phlebotomy Orders

Test: Therapeutic Phlebotomy

Explanation of change: Physician orders for therapeutic phlebotomy must have the patient's hemoglobin (HGB) cutoff requirement noted. Qualifying HGB test results must have been obtained within seven days of the procedure date. Phlebotomy will not be performed on patients with a hemoglobin of <10 g/dL without permission from the patient's physician.
